2057 To discuss resumption of the Neighbourhood Plan

- 2057.1 Councillor Cort reported that WDC could agree the resurrection of the old Neighbourhood Plan, but no action will be taken until Councillor Cort was available post-surgery:
- 2057.2 However Councillor B Hardman raised the point that the Government will be stopping funding for Neighbourhood Plans in 18 months to 2 years' time.

2058 To review the Risk Register including Little Beckford Playground

2058.1 No issues reported.

2059 Receive update regarding the RoSPA Inspection

- 2059.1 Following the Inspection, the Playground was inspected, and attention will be given to the points raised in the report.
- 2059.2 <u>It was agreed</u> to obtain a quote from Wicksteeds to address the items raised but other quotes could be obtained for the fencing.
- 2059.3 Councillors Bell and Bailey agreed to remove the barbed wire.

To discuss how the Flood Management Budget should be spent. It was agreed that a budget of £1000 to provide equipment, grit and sandbags be approved subject to location and access.

2060.1 Councillor Cort raised the possibility of using the strip of land next to the bus stop to house containers for sand and grit bags. However, it will be necessary to identify who owns the land-Highways or Wychavon. Councillor B Hardman offered to help determine with Wychavon and Councillor A Hardman would check with Highways..

2061 To update the position regarding the A46.

No update however it was suggested that Sedgeberrow Parish Council be contacted to see if they have noticed any improvements since implementing the 40 mph speed limit.

2062 To discuss progress with supporting the SafeAvon initiative.

2062.1 Councillor Worrall confirmed that she was still carrying out testing every week but there had been no improvements.

2063 To discuss an update to the Community Speedwatch project.

2063.1 No progress to report.

To consider update to the "Quiet Lane" proposal for Court Farm Lane. 2008.1 A Hardman confirmed that the use of "Quiet Lane" was not official County policy and could therefore not be used. He did confirm that they would be reinforcing signage along Court Farm Lane.

2064.1 Councillor A Hardman confirmed that Quite Lane signage is not available for Court Farm Lane under WCC policy but he will ask Barry Barnes to come out and see what could be done.

2065 To discuss issues raised regarding the recent repairs to the pavement on Cheltenham Road in LB.

2065.1 Councillor A Hardman confirmed that Barry Barnes had met with the residents. Barry Barnes had raised a 28 day notice to improve the footpath.

2066 To discuss the erection of a deer sign on the Ashton Rd.

2066.1 Councillor A Hardman discussed the locations were the deer/wildlife cross the highway and would undertake an inspection.

2067 To discuss replacement of the damaged wooden post on the junction of Main Street and Back Lane.

2067.1 Repairs have been undertaken therefore no further action is necessary.

2068 Discuss taking part in the survey on local government reorganisation in Worcestershire.

- 2068.1 Councillor B Hardman commented that that she doubted that all the councils will change to become unity. Councillor A Hardman was of the opinion that the government will impose its will regardless of the survey.
- 2068.2 A meeting would take place in September to discuss the results.
- 2068.3 There was concern over the impact upon Parish Councils

2069 To provide update regarding the defibrillators catastrophic bleed kit.

- 2069.1 Councillor Cort confirmed that she had sent an expression of interest for Rurall Funding.
- 2069.2 It was agreed that if funding became available, investigations would begin to see if a Defibrillator and Bleed you Kit could be installed at the Beckford Inn.

2070 To discuss the Newsletter.

- 2070.1 Councillor Cort requested that any entries for the newsletter be forwarded to her.
- 2070.2 It was noted that only a few "hits" had been made to the Newsletter page of the website and there was also a poor uptake of hardcopies from the three communities libraries.

2071 To discuss Councillor vacancy.

The vacancy would continue be advertised on the noticeboards, the website and included in the newsletter.
